### Note to Districts and Schools

- Schools are responsible for testing all students during the testing window.
- The ADE suggests that schools test students at the beginning of the testing window.

## Expected to Test

Each school district is responsible for ensuring that all students enrolled in the district are appropriately coded, accounted for and tested including:

- English Learners (EL)
  - Students in their first year in a US school take all subject tests
- Students with disabilities
- Students in an Alternative Learning Environment (ALE)
- Students in Therapeutic Day Treatment (TDT)
- Migrant students
- Students enrolled in Department of Youth Services (DYS)
- Transfer students (enrolling up to 4 days prior to the final day of the testing window)
- Homebound students

## Students that are not Expected to Test

School districts are responsible for ensuring that all students included in their eSchool enrollment are appropriately tested OR have a documented reason the student will not test. The following students, if enrolled in your district throughout the testing window, are not expected to test:

- Home-schooled students
- Incarcerated students
- Students in Residential Treatment Centers (overnight care)
- Students in Youth Challenge - Students must go to Youth Challenge before the opening of the window and they are expected to stay through the duration of program
- Students in Job Corps
- Students attending another school district under a tuition agreement
- Students with a medical emergency or hospitalized for the entire testing window
- Students enrolled at the Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences and Arts
- Applicable eSchool Resident Codes:
  - 1 = resident home school student No ADM - not enrolled in a credit-earning course (as determined by the district)
  - 2 = resident home school student with ADM
  - 4 = resident home/private school student with ADM
  - 5 = Home/Private School Student in Virtual Environment
