



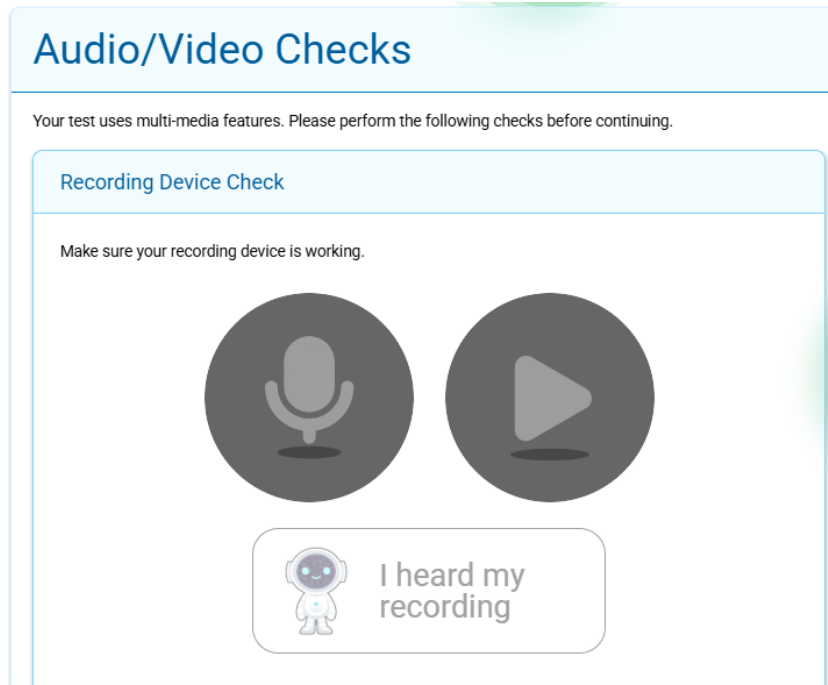
2025-2026 New Summative Testing Microphone Functionality

The microphone check before the ATLAS K–2 summative tests will be updated so that students and TAs can hear the student’s recorded response. This will help confirm that the microphone is working properly before testing begins.

This updated microphone check is now available before starting any of the ATLAS K–3 training tests (<https://arpt.cambiumtds.com/student>).

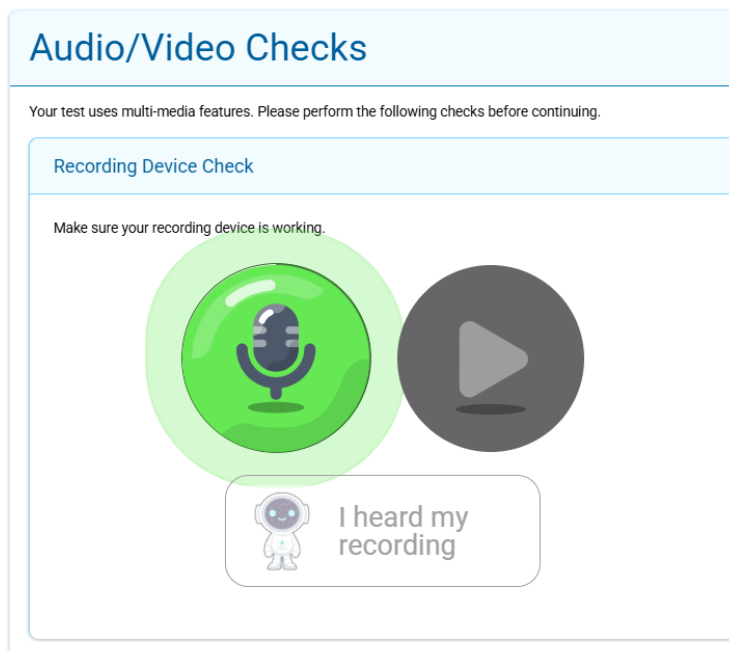
New Microphone Check Process

First, Cambi tells the student to say their name when the microphone turns green to confirm that it is working. All buttons are initially grayed out.

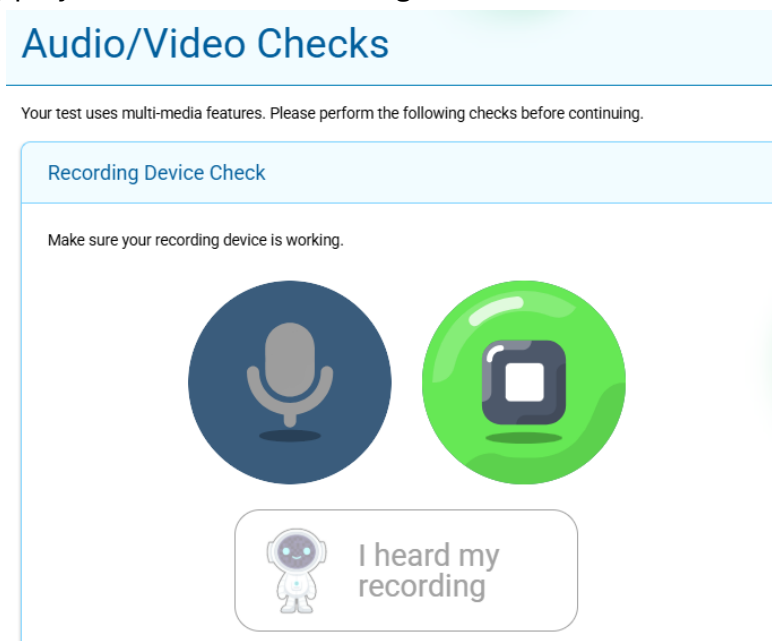


If the microphone captures the student's response:

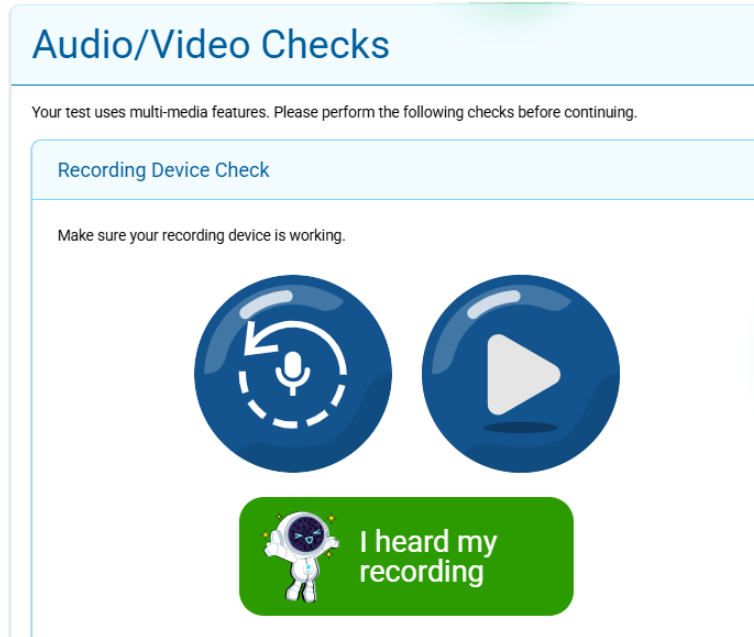
1. The halo around the microphone turns green when it captures sound.



2. After completing the recording, the play button on the right turns green and automatically plays the student's recording.

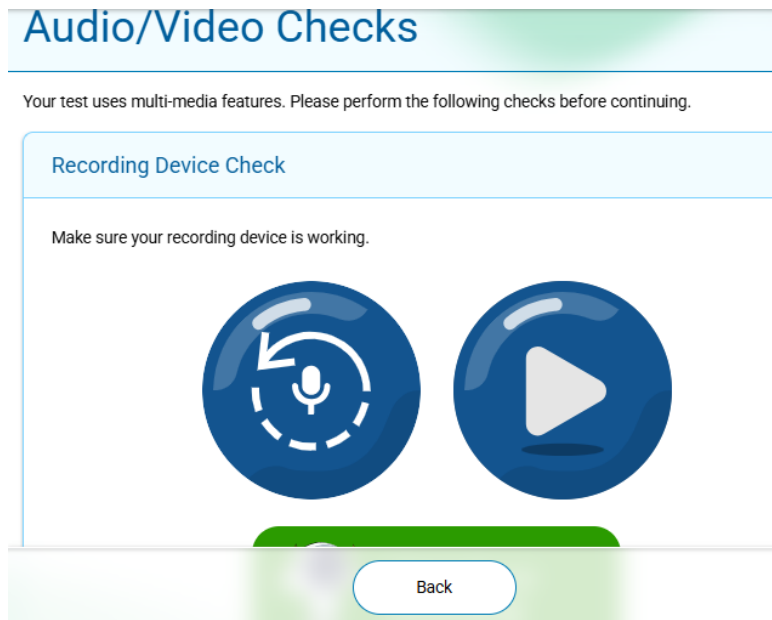


3. The “I heard my recording” below turns green. The student can select this button to start their test.

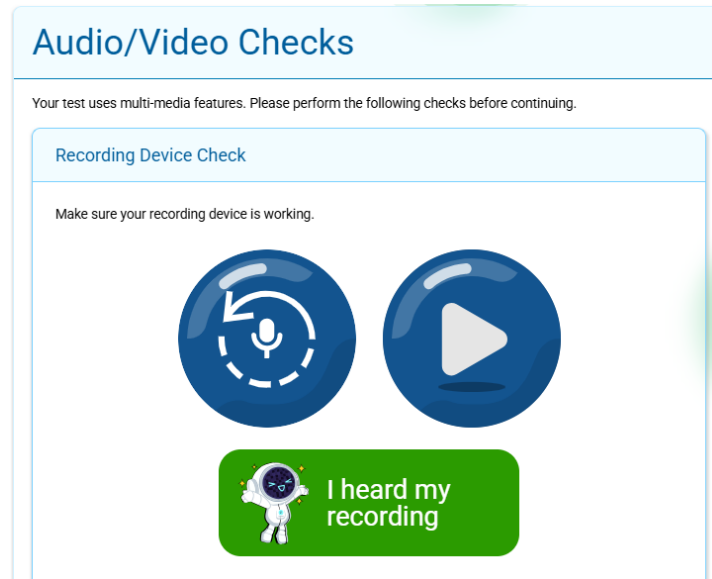


NOTES:

1. On some devices, the student may need to scroll down to see the “I heard my recording” button.



2. Selecting the microphone button on the left restarts the microphone check. Selecting the play button on the right replays the student's recording.

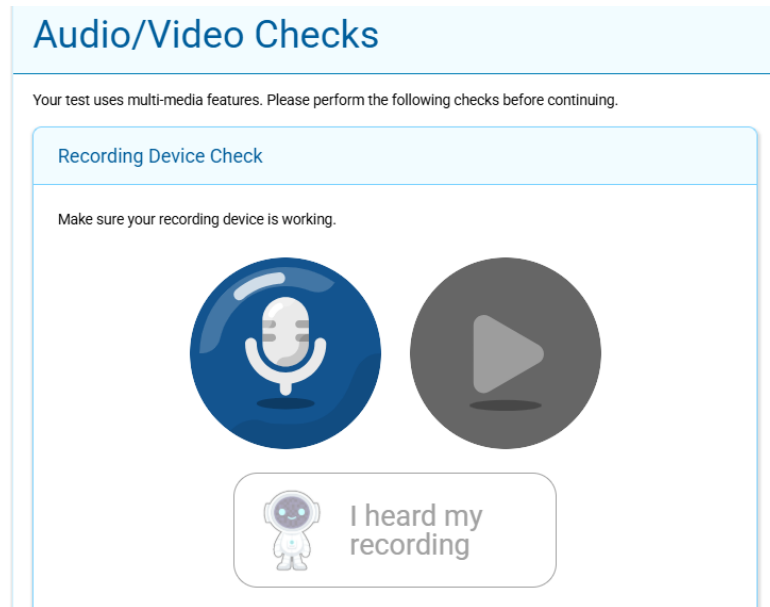


If the microphone does not capture the student's response:

1. The halo around the microphone remains red.



2. After attempting to record, the microphone resets to blue. Cambi prompts the student to raise their hand for assistance. The play and the “I heard my recording” buttons remain grayed out.



3. The student or TA can select the blue microphone button to try again. This process will repeat until the microphone successfully captures the recording.
