9:00 Shifting Boundaries: Lessons on Relationships for Students in Middle School

Dr. Nan D. Stein, Ed.D; Wellesley College Center for Research on Women Dr. Stein will share evaluation results after 10 years of funding (2005-2015) from the National Institute of Justice, the research arm of the US Dept. of Justice, demonstrated the effectiveness of Shifting Boundaries to reduce peer sexual harassment and precursors to teen dating violence among middle school students. An overview of sexual harassment in schools and teen dating violence will be provided through statistics from recent national studies. This session will provide participants with interactive opportunities to engage in understanding where on school campus schools can focus to ensure safe environments for students.
